- The chart shows us that in the 1890s immigrants mainly came from Europe. From the red line you can see that a smaller group of immigrants came from Asia.
- When you look at the chart of the 1990s you can see that then there were five big groups of immigrants. The blue line shows us that the biggest group of immigrants came from Latin America. From the red line you can see that the second biggest group came from Asia. Immigrants from Eastern and Southern Europe and from Northern and Western Europe were only the third and fourth biggest groups.
- But when you look at the yellow line you can see that immigrants from Africa were growing.
