- 10 "Hi, Tiger. Here's your food," says Sam. First he makes a hole in the tin and then he opens the tin and feeds Tiger.

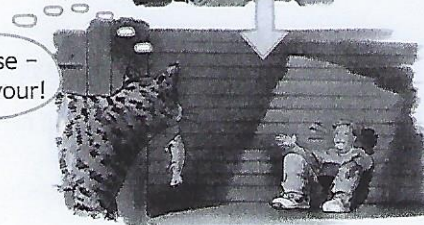
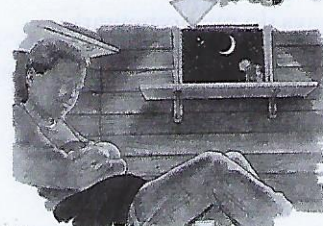
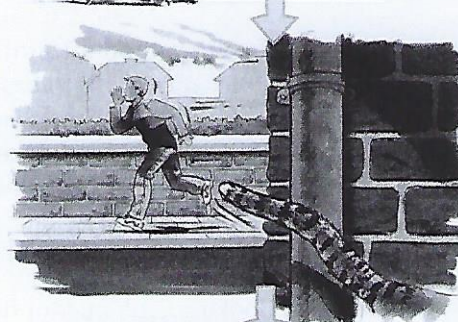
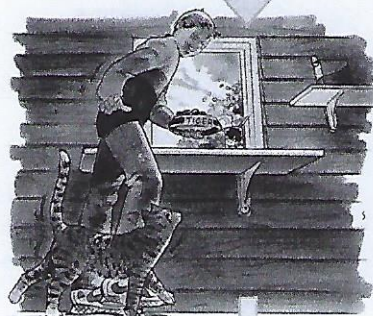
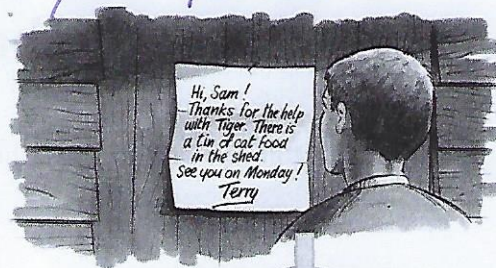
- But Tiger sees a dog and runs away. "Tiger!"
